- Four young people have made a personal and public decision to follow Jesus as their Lord and Savior
- God continues to supply needs:
  - Grant money for WCA/LFN has supplied needed equipment and furniture: tables, chairs, refrigerators and a washer/dryer.
  - Sadly, we must say goodbye to Mr. Smith (6<sup>th</sup>) and Mrs. Nicastro (5<sup>th</sup>). At the beginning of the year they informed us that they may need to move out of state this coming year. We obviously did not want to see that happen. But has provided Mr. Rossell (6<sup>th</sup>) Ms. Beebe (5<sup>th</sup>) and Mrs. Schumacher (4<sup>th</sup>). Ms Bond will assist in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade. We have added Mr. Berry, Mr. Tim South and Mr. Frazee to our cleaning crew. Ms. Kate, Mrs. Sayers and Mr. Smith are the new faces in LFN.
  - Food and health products are donated regularly.
  - Volunteers are stepping up regularly
- A fantastic WCA “in-service” challenged us to be mindful of ministering to children in need. Sessions covered topics for those hearing impaired, on the Autism spectrum, and those with limited mobility. We hope to continue this theme as we seek how to help those visually impaired and more.
- Nearly \$275,000 in financial aid was granted to the 2019-2020 WCA for nearly 150 students this year. If you know of some donors that would like to offset this cost please have them contact us.

Pandemic: Needless-to-say, we are all weary of information pertaining to the pandemic. Especially wearisome is the everchanging guidelines.
