What different internships do you offer?

Are internships mandatory?

Internships are not mandatory. However, we highly encourage this as students will gain a variety of benefits from these positive experiences as well as work experience.

Will the internships be every day?

We will be keeping the internship days to Tuesday and Thursday mornings.

Will regular classes still be expected?

Regular classes will be expected and scheduled at a time that our interns will still have the availability to attend.

Will the internship earn high school credits?

The internship will earn 2 high school credits for the time and effort required by the program.

Will tuition be reduced due to the internship?

No, this is an unpaid internship to help earn credits, gain skills in a specialized area of study, and experience the professionalism of a workplace and the protocol that accompanies it.

Can internships earn required community service hours?

Yes, community service hours can be earned through the internship programs.

Are other classes offered that specifically correspond to the internships?

Currently we offer one class that corresponds with the LFN Internship. It is our plan and goal to develop others.

Is there limited space for each internship?

Yes, most internships have limited space of 2-3 per program.

Will rides be provided by WCA Staff members to the location if it is off campus?

No, rides cannot be provided across the board for all interns, however rides may be available through others within the program/participating ministry at the discretion of the parents. Students with vehicles may also transport themselves and others with parental permission.

Will my student still be able to participate in dual education through participating colleges if they do an internship?

Yes, the dual program through participating colleges in the area, and the internships we offer are two separate programs. 11th and 12th graders may choose to be involved in both.
