



WCA Cell Phone Policy

Expectation:

Websterville Christian Academy high school students may bring their phones to school. Students who bring their phones to school should keep their phones off & secured in their lockers, pockets, bags or cars and should not be seen with their phones during the school day (8:00 AM – 2:45 PM), unless otherwise explicitly given permission from a WCA staff member. If a student has a phone out in a classroom, hallway, or restroom, the phone will be confiscated. Students will be required to uphold “Acceptable Use Technology Policy” for using any electronics on school premises. Under no circumstances is a student permitted to record, either audibly or visually, any person on school property without written consent from all parties involved.

Consequences:

Confiscated phones will be sent to the office and will remain there until the student pays a \$10 fine or a parent comes in to pick up the phone. Any student who records an individual on school property without written consent of that person will face consequences up to and including removal from Websterville Christian Academy.

Expectation:

Students will be required to stay on our school's WIFI and will not be allowed to have any VPNs connected to their device.

Consequence:

Failure to comply with these will result in possible confiscation of their device.
