Greetings from Websterville Christian Academy!

Allow me to introduce Websterville Christian Academy (WCA). It was founded in 1976 as a private K-12 school. Until 2021, the school operated out of the Websterville Baptist Church (WBC) and the church's auxiliary buildings located on Church Hill Road in Websterville, VT. Starting at the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year we moved the K-12 classes to Vine Street in Berlin, VT, to what had been the Seventh Day Adventists school and church, we presently lease the facility.

In today's world, a well-run and administered private school, whether it be secular or parochial, serves as an oasis for our children. We believe that school-age children are not only in desperate need of a safe learning environment but also for the Word and love of God. At WCA, we continue to see how our approach and strategy for learning positively impacts our students and has become a beacon for others. Families of public-school students are requesting to transfer to WCA even midway through the year. Listed below are some reasons why parents feel the need to make a move to a Christian centered education.

1. WCA uses a well-established, age-appropriate curriculum that prepares our students to be well-rounded individuals, not only in the basics, reading, writing, math, history, and science, but also foreign language, civics, health, life skills, and Bible.
2. WCA provides some (however not as extensive as the public sector) alternative educational opportunities to teach students with disabilities.
3. WCA is committed to providing a quality education that is distinctively biblical by design.
4. WCA is a school with a vision for the future. We are committed to providing an educational experience which enhances the intellectual, social, spiritual, and physical development of the student, staff, and parents. We equip our students to be leaders that influence others to do right.

WCA has not been without its challenges over the last 45 years. But through the grace of God, we have remained steadfast as a light for Central Vermont.

Our move to the Vine Street campus has shown us the great opportunities that such a facility can offer, like spacious classrooms, ample space for outdoor activities, a well-equipped kitchen, and a large auditorium/gymnasium that can serve so many purposes! This amazing campus also provides us with the opportunity to grow – this facility is ideal!

Our Challenge: Throughout the tenure of WCA, as a mission of Websterville Baptist Church; the church has been able to assist with any monetary shortfalls. Although budgeting for the move

When we begin the process of purchasing the property, we will call in your commitment in order to complete the purchase.
